WHAT WILL YOU DO AT CAMP?

DAY 5 | Raft the Colorado River. Show your best moves at the camp dance.

DAY 6 | Tour Trapper Coal Mine and Craig Generation Plant. Enjoy the end-of-camp banquet.

DAY 7 | Return home.

This trip is unlike any other. If selected, your local electric co-op will send you on an all-expenses-paid trip to a rustic Colorado mountain camp with other high school youth from four states. So pack your bug spray and hiking shoes, and get ready to build memories that will last a lifetime.
